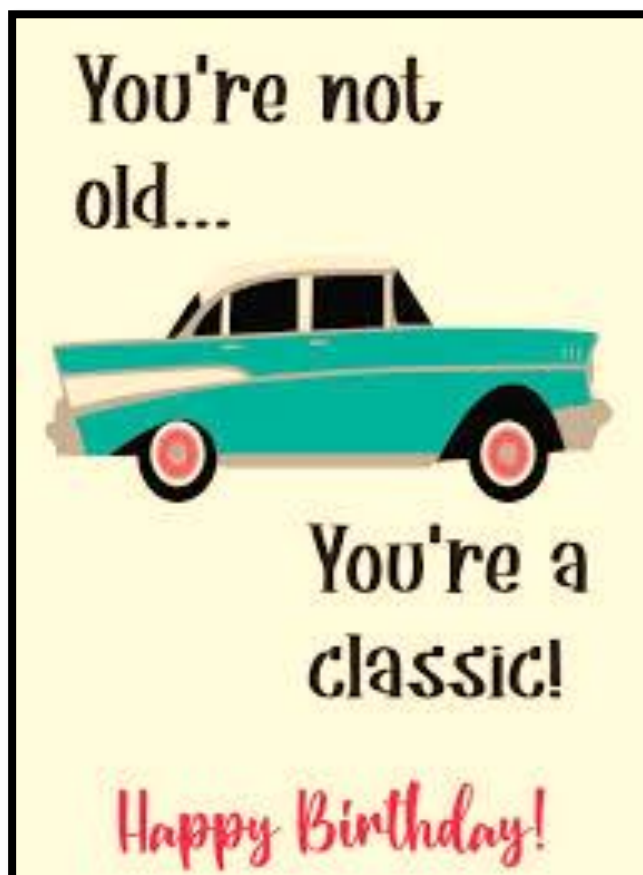

IMPROMPTU RUN RULES FOR FINANCIAL MEMBERS OF The Curvettes & The Potbellies Car Club Inc.

For members on Concessional Registration wishing to use their car on an Impromptu Run, you need to register your run on our Facebook page.

For an Impromptu Run to be valid, the registered car owner must be a current financial member of The Curvettes & The Potbellies Car Club Inc at the time of the event.

An Impromptu run can be started as soon as it is logged on to our Facebook page. Events cannot be placed on the Facebook page after the event, as this will be automatically regarded as invalid. Impromptu runs cannot be work related.

When creating an Impromptu event on our Facebook page, you must include:-

Your name
Car details and
Registration number of car
Start time and date Destination
Estimated finish time and date

Non compliance of these rules may compromise the car owners insurance and registration.

Concessional Registration is a privilege, as is Impromptu Events, do the right thing, please don't abuse it.
